- 1. An individual who wishes to be a candidate is not required to be an attorney, but must be an "eligible elector" pursuant to Iowa law. See Iowa Code §§ 46.10(1), 46.25, 39.3, and 48A.5.
- 2. Note that the petition is two pages. The individual who is seeking to have his/her name placed on the ballot should complete the top of the petition (including the judicial election district number) on the first page. Including a profession is optional, but it may help the voters identify and research candidates with whom they are not acquainted.
- 3. Collect the required ten original signatures as well as the printed names, full home addresses and signature dates for all individuals who sign the petition. Please ensure all information collected is legible (for verification purposes).
- 4. Complete the second page of the petition (the candidate's sworn statement) to confirm the validity of the candidate and the individuals for whom the signatures are being submitted. Please read the sworn statement carefully and consider whether you meet the requirements for the position before signing it. This commissioner will serve the remainder of an unexpired term, not a full six-year term.

All <u>completed</u> petitions with sworn statements must be received in the office of State Court Administration no later than August 12, 2024, in order to place a name on the ballot.

6. Individuals who do not submit completed petitions and whose names are not included on ballots may still receive votes during the voting period as a write-in candidate.
